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Use of SmartMusic:

- 1. Gives students sense of pitch/tuning (visualize the tuning process)
- 2. Gives students sense of playing with a steady beat (internalize the beat)
- 3. Reinforces time signature & key signature (how many "clicks" will you get?)

Wouldn't it be something if kids could learn their parts outside of the classroom – and just put it all together in the rehearsal!
